CASE SUMMARY:

Victim [REDACTED] reported that on 1/11/06 she was shown a video on suspect John "Chris" Ryan's computer by his girlfriend, Ethel "Lisa" Velasquez. [REDACTED] stated Velasquez had called her and told her to come to Ryan's room in Reynolds Hall. [REDACTED] stated she immediately went to Reynolds Hall and Velasquez met her at an exterior door to let her in. [REDACTED] stated she and Velasquez were the only ones present in the room when she arrived. [REDACTED] stated Velasquez showed her a video on Ryan's computer. [REDACTED] stated the video was taken in November 2005 when she slept in Ryan's room in Reynolds Hall. [REDACTED] stated the video showed her while she was asleep in his bed. [REDACTED] stated the camera would zoom in on her face while she was sleeping and zoom in on Ryan's penis. [REDACTED] stated Ryan was masturbating over her in the video and she was unaware of what was occurring. [REDACTED] stated she went to bed fully clothed with the covers over her. [REDACTED] stated she did not watch the entire video and does not know what else was on it. [REDACTED] stated Velasquez accused her of being more than just friends with Ryan. [REDACTED] stated Ryan came to the room after she viewed the video and they argued. [REDACTED] stated she has been friends with Ryan and Velasquez since High School. [REDACTED] reported this incident to Rod Colas, Coordinator, Jennie Murphree/Reynolds Hall on 1/11/06 and also spoke with a victim advocate on that same date. [REDACTED] met with me on 1/12/06 to file a report.

Ryan refused to speak with me regarding this case and would not provide permission for me to view his computer.

I interviewed Velasquez and placed her under oath prior to her providing any testimony. Velasquez denied she showed [REDACTED] a video or pictures on Ryan's computer. Velasquez denied any knowledge of this video. Velasquez stated she did call [REDACTED] and tell her to come to Ryan's room on 1/11/06. Velasquez stated Ryan was in the room when she called [REDACTED] and when [REDACTED] arrived. Velasquez denied she and [REDACTED] were alone in the room. Velasquez stated [REDACTED] had come to visit FSU in November and was in Ryan's room. Velasquez stated Ryan and [REDACTED] told her that [REDACTED] was not going to sleep in his room. Velasquez stated she asked Ryan on 1/11/06 if [REDACTED] stayed in his room in November and he told her yes. Velasquez stated Ryan left and went to class. Velasquez stated Ryan had class from 11:15 a.m. to 12:05 p.m. but he got out a little early. Velasquez stated she called [REDACTED] when Ryan returned from class and told her to come to Ryan's room. Velasquez stated [REDACTED] came to Ryan's room and she confronted her about sleeping in Ryan's room in November.

[REDACTED] stated that Velasquez had called her cellular phone on 1/11/06 telling her to come to Ryan's room "right now". [REDACTED] stated Velasquez was upset and crying.

█ stated she went to Reynolds Hall immediately and Velasquez met her at a door. █ stated they went to Ryan's room and were alone in the room. █ provided me with her cellular phone records. █ cellular phone number is █. █ received incoming calls from Velasquez's cellular phone number of █ on 1/11/06 at 11:43 a.m. and 11:46 a.m. █ stated during the first call she could not hear Velasquez well and Velasquez called back. █ stated after the second call she left right away and was at Reynolds Hall within a few minutes. █ resides in Jennie Murphree Hall which is directly beside Reynolds Hall. Ryan was scheduled for class on 1/11/06 from 11:15 a.m. - 12:05 p.m.

I obtained Ryan's card swipes for Reynolds Hall on 1/11/06. The exterior doors of Reynolds Hall are secured magnetically and residents are required to utilize their FSU I.D. Card to gain entry. The log shows Ryan utilized his I.D. card to enter Reynolds Hall on 1/11/06 at 12:04 p.m. The only time he used it prior to that time on 1/11/06 was at 1:41 a.m. █ stated she called her mother after leaving Ryan's room. █ phone records show she called her mother's number at 12:08 p.m. This supports the account of events provided by █ and indicates that Velasquez provided false information under oath. The records show that Velasquez called █ prior to Ryan returning to Reynolds Hall and that █ was most likely in the room with Velasquez before Ryan returned. This contradicts Velasquez's statement that she called █ after Ryan returned from class. Velasquez was provided with an opportunity to clarify her statement and declined.

The victim decided to pursue charges through the Office of Student Rights and Responsibilities in lieu of pursuing criminal charges.

Velasquez was charged criminally with Perjury, Not in an Official Proceeding, 837.012, F.S., Misdemeanor 1st.

INVESTIGATIVE ENTRIES:

On 1/11/06 Jacqui Pequignot, Director, FSU Victim Advocate Program made contact with me regarding a female she spoke with in reference to someone videotaping her without her knowledge. Pequignot advised the female wished to file a report and arrangements were made for Pequignot and the female to meet with me on 1/12/06 at 2:00 p.m.

On 1/12/06 at approximately 9:45 a.m., FSU Communications Officer Harbin contacted me and advised that a female, identified as █ had just called FSU PD attempting to make contact with Pequignot. Harbin advised the female was extremely upset and Pequignot was not immediately available. Harbin provided me with █ cell number. I made contact with █ via her cell phone. █ was crying and it was apparent she was upset. █ stated she had been upset about the discovery of a videotape yesterday where a friend had taped her without her knowledge. █ stated she called him this morning and yelled at him.

█████ stated he does not think he did anything wrong. █████ calmed down and said she was alright and would meet with me at 2:00 p.m. that day.

On 1/12/06 at approximately 2:00 p.m. Pequignot and █████ met with me at FSU PD regarding this incident.

█████ reported that on 1/11/06 she was shown a video where she was secretly videotaped by suspect John "Chris" Ryan while she slept in his room. █████ stated his real first name is John but he goes by "Chris". █████ stated that Ryan exposed his penis in the video and was masturbating. █████ stated she was under the bed covers in the portion of the video she saw. █████ stated the incident occurred sometime in mid November 2005.

█████ provided the following details. She met Ryan in High School and they have been good friends since about 2001. █████ stated she and Ryan have only had a platonic relationship. █████ stated this is her first semester at FSU. █████ stated that Ryan was at FSU during the Fall 2005 semester and she and her parents came to visit FSU in November 2005. █████ stated when they came to visit FSU during that time; she stayed the night in Ryan's room at Reynolds Hall, Room 040. █████ stated on 1/11/06 Ryan's girlfriend, identified as Ethel "Lisa" Velasquez called her and told her to come to Ryan's room. █████ stated that Velasquez also went to the same High School and she has known her about two years. █████ stated she went to Ryan's room and only she and Velasquez were in the room. █████ did not know the exact time. █████ stated that Velasquez was on Ryan's laptop computer and showed her a video on the computer. █████ stated the video showed her when she was sleeping in Ryan's bed during her November visit. █████ stated that Ryan would focus on her face and also focus on his penis. █████ stated she went to bed fully clothed and under the covers and the video showed the covers over her. █████ stated she was alone in Ryan's bed and he was standing over her. █████ stated Ryan was masturbating over her, that his hand would be on his penis and when the camera focused on her face the image was shaky. █████ stated she has problems sleeping and takes Unisom to help her sleep. █████ stated she took Unisom when she stayed in Ryan's room in November. █████ stated it would have been difficult for something to wake her up. █████ stated Ryan's roommate was not in the room that night. █████ stated she did not watch the entire video because she was to upset so she does not know what else may have occurred. █████ stated that Ryan had several photographs of her and other females on his computer. █████ stated it appeared some of the photographs of her had been downloaded from other sites. █████ stated Velasquez appeared to think she and Ryan had something going on other than friendship. █████ stated that Velasquez was upset and called Ryan to come to his room. █████ stated that she confronted Ryan about the videotape and he did not say much. █████ stated later that day she called Ryan and told him to meet her at his car in the parking garage. █████ stated she had personal belongings in his car and wanted to get them. █████ stated he met her at his car and she obtained her belongings.

I explained the crime of Voyeurism to [REDACTED] and informed her I was not sure if this incident would meet the criteria but would check with the State Attorney's Office. I explained [REDACTED] options to her. I explained if the State Attorney's Office stated this incident met the criteria for Voyeurism I may be able to obtain a search warrant for Ryan's computer. I explained the process for criminal charges and charges through Housing and the Office of Student Rights and Responsibilities.

[REDACTED] stated that Ryan has probably destroyed the video by now. [REDACTED] stated she called him earlier this morning and yelled at him about it. [REDACTED] stated on 1/11/06 she told Ryan she was going to report him to the police. [REDACTED] stated that Ryan's father is a lawyer so he would probably call him. [REDACTED] stated that Velasquez initially broke it off with Ryan but then took him back. [REDACTED] did not believe that Velasquez would be cooperative.

[REDACTED] was not sure what action she wished taken. [REDACTED] stated she has known Ryan for a long time and is close to his parents. [REDACTED] stated she wanted to think about her options and would let me know. [REDACTED] stated the least she would want me to do is talk to Ryan about this so he knows what he did was wrong.

[REDACTED] stated she is going out of town this weekend and will contact me next week and advise what action she wished taken. It was decided that I would wait on [REDACTED] decision before taking any action.

On 1/19/06 at approximately 3:35 p.m. I spoke with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] stated she has decided that she does not want to pursue criminal charges. [REDACTED] stated she did want Ryan issued a trespass warning for her Residence Hall. [REDACTED] asked about a restraining order. I advised [REDACTED] that a restraining order issued through the court requires either two acts or two threats of violence in the past six months. I advised [REDACTED] that the Office of Student Rights and Responsibilities could issue a no contact order to Ryan. I explained the order could only be enforced through the school. [REDACTED] stated she wished to have the no contact order issued. [REDACTED] stated she wanted this case referred to the Office of Student Rights and Responsibilities. [REDACTED] stated she would like it if they could require him to go to some type of counseling.

I advised [REDACTED] I would be contacting Ryan and Velasquez and attempt to interview them regarding this case. I advised [REDACTED] I would let her know when the trespass warning was issued to Ryan. [REDACTED] provided me with cellular phone numbers for Ryan and Velasquez. Ryan's is [REDACTED] and Velasquez's is [REDACTED]

On 1/19/06 at approximately 3:45 p.m. I attempted to make contact with Ryan via his cellular phone. Ryan answered and stated he was in class. Ryan stated this class would end at 4:50 p.m. I advised Ryan I would call him after that.

On 1/19/06 at approximately 5:00 p.m. I made contact with Ryan via his cellular phone. Ryan asked what this was about and I told him it was about an incident [REDACTED] reported. I explained what she reported and what she saw on his computer.

Ryan stated he has done nothing wrong. Ryan asked is this about the argument he, his girlfriend and [REDACTED] had last week. I advised it probably had something to do with it. Ryan did not deny or admit that the videotape existed, only that he did nothing wrong. Ryan stated that [REDACTED] has problems and I should check her history out. I explained to Ryan that [REDACTED] did not wish to pursue criminal charges but wanted the case referred to the Dean of Student's Office. Ryan stated he didn't understand what this was about. I explained to Ryan that [REDACTED] has given her version of events and I wanted to meet with him so he could provide me with his. I explained if he did not speak with me, the report would only have what [REDACTED] said occurred. I asked Ryan if he would allow me to look at this computer. Ryan stated his father has been a prosecutor and defense attorney and he knows to go through him. Ryan stated he would not meet with me unless his father told him to. Ryan stated he would call his father and have him contact me.

On 1/19/06 at approximately 5:20 p.m. John Ryan [REDACTED] father of suspect John "Chris" Ryan made contact with me via telephone. J. Ryan asked what this was about. I explained the situation to J. Ryan and informed him this report would be referred to the Office of Student Rights and Responsibilities. I explained that I wanted to give his son the opportunity to provide his account of events or any other information. J. Ryan said his son was a good person and has never been in trouble. J. Ryan said I needed to check her background that she has been in trouble several times. J. Ryan said I need to ask [REDACTED] about the 45 year old man who was going to pay her way through FAU, about what her boyfriend really did, about gifts her mother gave her to bring to school and other things. J. Ryan said I need to check [REDACTED] criminal history. J. Ryan said he could not believe that FSU did not do backgrounds on applicants and allowed someone like her to be admitted. J. Ryan said she has only been at FSU two weeks and is already causing trouble. J. Ryan asked me when the video was allegedly made and I told him in November. J. Ryan said his son did not get his video camera until Christmas. J. Ryan questioned why I would send this report to the Dean of Student's Office based on what [REDACTED] said. I explained that if someone filed a report and wanted it referred to the Office of Student Rights and Responsibilities, I complete the report, conduct an investigation and forward it to them. I explained again to J. Ryan that I wanted his son to meet with me to provide his account of events. J. Ryan said he would not allow his son to provide a statement. J. Ryan asked if [REDACTED] could be charged with filing a false report. I explained that there was no indication she filed a false report and if his son and his son's girlfriend are not willing to speak with me, then there would be no evidence to suggest [REDACTED] filed a false report. J. Ryan said he wanted to be kept informed of everything and he would represent his son at the hearing. I explained I did not know if there would be a hearing or when it would be. I explained his son would be notified by the Office of Student Rights and Responsibilities. I informed J. Ryan that I would attempt to contact his son tomorrow in order to issue him a trespass warning for Jennie Murphree Hall. J. Ryan said if I did that I better issue her one for his residence. I informed J. Ryan since his son would not meet with me, if there is anything he would like me to put

with this report he could email me or give me something in writing. J. Ryan did not give me any indication that he would do that.

On 1/20/06 at approximately 10:15 a.m. Officer J. Simmons and I made contact with Ryan at his residence in 040 Reynolds Hall. I issued Ryan a trespass warning for Jennie Murphree Hall, including the interior and immediate exterior curtilage. Ryan said he walks through the breezeway between Reynolds and Jennie Murphree Hall. I told Ryan to stay in the center and the Reynolds Hall side of the breezeway. Ryan signed the trespass warning card acknowledging receipt of the trespass warning. Ryan asked what about her. I asked what he meant. He said his father said he told me he wanted her issued a trespass warning for Reynolds. I told Ryan that he hasn't given me any information that would give me a reason to issue her a trespass warning. I informed Ryan I would however tell her she should stay away.

I forwarded information on the trespass warning issued to Ryan to Chandra Myricke, Asst. Director, Residence Life, Rod Colas, Coordinator, Jennie Murphree Hall/Reynolds Hall and Alaina Krebs, Asst. Coordinator Jennie Murphree Hall/Reynolds Hall.

On 1/20/06 at approximately 12:30 p.m. I made contact with Velasquez via her cellular phone. I advised Velasquez who I was and that I needed to speak with her about something that occurred last week that [REDACTED] reported. Velasquez stated she did find out last week that [REDACTED] had spent the night in Ryan's room, she believes in November and she had confronted them about it. Velasquez stated she was currently at Thagard Health Center and asked if I could call her back. I asked Velasquez if she could come to FSU PD and speak with me when she left Thagard. Velasquez did not know where FSU PD was or landmarks near it. Velasquez stated she would call me when she left Thagard to get directions.

I made contact with [REDACTED] via telephone and informed her Ryan was issued a trespass warning for Jennie Murphree Hall.

On 1/20/06 at approximately 2:40 p.m. Velasquez called me from her cellular phone. My caller I.D. confirmed the number she called from was [REDACTED]. Velasquez stated other things had come up and she was not able to meet with me when she left Thagard. Velasquez said she was at the Love Building and would come meet with me now. I gave her directions to FSU PD.

On 1/20/06 at approximately 2:50 p.m. Velasquez met with me at FSU PD. Velasquez's first name is Ethel but she goes by "Lisa". Velasquez provided a sworn audio recorded statement and was placed under oath by me before providing her statement. A summary of Velasquez's statement is as follows: Velasquez stated she, [REDACTED] and Chris have known each other since High School. Velasquez stated that sometime in November 2005 [REDACTED] came to Tallahassee with her parents to visit. Velasquez stated that one of the nights during [REDACTED] visit, she, [REDACTED] and Chris were in Chris's room and she had a suspicion that [REDACTED]

was going to stay in Chris's room. Velasquez stated she asked both of them if [REDACTED] was going back to the hotel and they both told her yes and that she was not going to stay in Chris's room that Chris was going to take her to the hotel. Velasquez stated that she took the safe bus back to her dorm. Velasquez stated that she had her suspicions that [REDACTED] had stayed in Chris's room. Velasquez stated she asked Chris the next day and he said [REDACTED] did not stay in his room. Velasquez stated on the night of 1/10/06 she (Velasquez) stayed in Chris's room. Velasquez stated she had been thinking about it because [REDACTED] is back in town and their dorms are next to each other. Velasquez stated on the morning of 1/11/06 before Chris went to class she confronted him again about the night in November and asked if [REDACTED] spent the night in his room. Velasquez stated Chris told her yes, and that nothing happened, that [REDACTED] slept in the bed and he slept on the floor. Velasquez stated Chris left and went to class. Velasquez stated Chris got out of class a little early and came back to the room. Velasquez stated she told Chris she wanted to call [REDACTED] and confront her about it. Velasquez stated she called [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] came over about ten minutes later. Velasquez stated Chris was in the room during that time. Velasquez stated she asked [REDACTED] if she stayed in Chris's room that night in November and [REDACTED] looked over at Chris. Velasquez said she told [REDACTED] that Chris said she did. Velasquez stated [REDACTED] told her she did. Velasquez stated [REDACTED] got really mad at Chris and told Chris he should not have told her. Velasquez questioned why he shouldn't have told her if nothing happened. Velasquez denied that she was on Chris' laptop. Velasquez denied being on Chris' laptop and finding pictures or the video that [REDACTED] mentioned. Velasquez stated Chris told her something about a video and that it was ridiculous. Velasquez stated she did not know where all this is coming from. Velasquez stated the three of them were in the room together. I explained to Velasquez that it did not make sense for [REDACTED] to make something like that up. Velasquez stated she doesn't know where all that is coming from and that she knows nothing about the video. I asked her if she was upset about pictures he had of other females. Velasquez stated no, there were pictures on there of friends. I asked Velasquez if she was sure she did not call [REDACTED] over while Chris was not in the room. Velasquez stated no, that Chris was there. I asked Velasquez what time Chris came back and when she called [REDACTED]. Velasquez stated Chris had a theater class at 11:15 a.m. and he got out a little early. Velasquez couldn't recall how early. I explained that there would be cell phone records indicating when she called [REDACTED]. I advised her that Chris' class was from 11:15 to 12:05. Velasquez stated she is almost positive he got out early. Velasquez stated she had not heard anything about a video or anything until Chris told her about someone from FSU PD calling him about it. I asked Velasquez if she had ever seen Chris with a video camera. Velasquez thought about it and said she was thinking about what he got for his birthday and what he got for Christmas. Velasquez said he got it for Christmas from his Aunt Kathleen. I asked Velasquez about the date in November when [REDACTED] came up. Velasquez stated she believes it was the weekend after her father's birthday and his birthday was November 5. Velasquez stated she thinks this whole thing is to break her and Chris up. I advised Velasquez that I got the impression [REDACTED] and Chris have been friends since the 9th grade and that [REDACTED] was not interested in him other

than being friends. I told Velasquez if [REDACTED] wanted to break them up she could have told Velasquez before that she slept in Chris's room. I mentioned to Velasquez that if Chris was innocent he should speak with me and say it did not happen. Velasquez stated that he has a busy schedule and probably does not think he should waste his time with the bullshit charges.

I made contact with [REDACTED] via telephone and informed her I had met with Velasquez. I advised [REDACTED] that Velasquez had denied showing her anything on Chris' computer and that Velasquez said Chris was in the room when she called her and when she came over. I asked [REDACTED] if she could obtain her phone records so I could view the time when Velasquez called her. [REDACTED] stated she would attempt to obtain the records and call me back.

On 1/20/06 at approximately 4:50 p.m. [REDACTED] made contact with me and advised she was able to obtain her phone records on line and had a printout of the incoming and outgoing phone calls. I advised [REDACTED] that I would meet with her at her residence.

On 1/20/06 at approximately 4:55 p.m. I met with [REDACTED] at her residence. [REDACTED] provided me with the phone log she had obtained for her cellular number of [REDACTED]. The log shows the following:

note: [REDACTED] stated she could hardly hear Velasquez and Velasquez called back.

1/11/06 11:46 a.m. received call from [REDACTED] (Velasquez's number)
note: [REDACTED] stated Velasquez called back and was extremely upset and told her to come to Chris' room. [REDACTED] stated she went over right after receiving this call.

1/11/06 12:08p.m. outgoing call to [REDACTED] ([REDACTED] mothers number)
note: [REDACTED] stated this is her mother's number and she called her after leaving Chris's room

1/11/06 12:26 p.m. received call from [REDACTED] (Velasquez's number)
note: [REDACTED] stated Velasquez called her and said she had called Chris's parents and told them.

1/11/06 12:30 p.m. outgoing call to [REDACTED] (Ryan's number)

1/11/06 12:52 p.m. incoming call from [REDACTED] (Ryan's number)

When I initially met with [REDACTED] on 1/12/06 I did not obtain a recorded statement because [REDACTED] was not sure what action she wished taken. I obtained a sworn audio recorded statement from [REDACTED] when I met with her in her room on 1/20/06. A summary of [REDACTED] statement is as follows: [REDACTED] stated she met Chris and Ethel in High School. She was friends with Chris and met Ethel and became friends with her through Chris. In November she came to Tallahassee with her parents. On one of the nights she hung out with Chris and Ethel and stayed in Chris' room. [REDACTED] stated Ethel was in the room and left before they went to sleep. [REDACTED] stated she and Chris had a strictly platonic relationship. [REDACTED] stated Chris insisted on sleeping in the bed with her and she told him no. [REDACTED] stated Chris slept on the floor and she slept in his bed. [REDACTED] stated the next morning her parents picked her up at Westcott. [REDACTED] stated on 1/11/06 Ethel called her and was really upset. [REDACTED] stated the first time Ethel called her it got disconnected. [REDACTED] stated Ethel called back and was crying and told her she needed her to come over, that she was really upset and needed her right away. [REDACTED] stated she went right over to Reynolds and it only took her a couple of minutes to get there. [REDACTED] stated that Ethel was waiting for her at the second entrance to the left at Reynolds to let her in. [REDACTED] stated they went in Chris' room and it was only the two of them. [REDACTED] stated Ethel sat down at the computer and said "what is this?". [REDACTED] stated Ethel clicked on something and it was a video. [REDACTED] stated she saw her face on the screen while she was sleeping and initially thought it was a picture. [REDACTED] stated she asked Ethel what this was. [REDACTED] stated Ethel told Chris to get your ass here now. [REDACTED] asked Ethel to give her the phone and Ethel would not because she did not want Chris to know she was in the room. [REDACTED] stated Ethel called Chris back and asked where he was and told him she was freaking out. [REDACTED] stated Chris told Ethel he was on his way. [REDACTED] stated Chris came home and she argued with him and told him to tell Ethel the truth, that they have never done anything. [REDACTED] stated she told Chris not to ever call her again. [REDACTED] stated Ethel called her later and said she notified his parents. [REDACTED] stated she called Chris later and told him to meet her at his car so she could get her stuff. [REDACTED] stated Chris did not want to. [REDACTED] stated she told Chris unless he wants to go to jail, he better meet her. [REDACTED] stated she talked to Ethel later and Ethel told her she had taken Chris back because she had cheated on him before. I asked [REDACTED] for more details about the video. [REDACTED] stated it clearly showed his

penis and his hand on his penis. [REDACTED] stated she did not watch the entire video and does not know what occurred later. [REDACTED] stated as soon as she saw his penis and what he was doing she quit watching.

I forwarded a request to Jeffrey Maddox, Office of Telecommunications Security and requested a log of card swipes for Ryan at Reynolds Hall on 1/11/06.

Because Ryan's father mentioned [REDACTED] had a criminal history, I had Communications Officer Harbin conduct a criminal history check. No criminal record was located on [REDACTED]

On 1/23/06 I received a voice message from Ryan's father, Mr. John Ryan requesting I contact him at [REDACTED]. At approximately 2:30 p.m. I made contact with J. Ryan via telephone. J. Ryan asked about the case and I informed him the case would be referred to the Office of Student Rights and Responsibilities when it was closed. J. Ryan asked about the trespass warning issued to his son and said he authorized me to issue him one if she was also issued one. I explained that he did not need to give authorization for me to issue his son a trespass warning. J. Ryan asked why she was not issued one. I explained that his son has not given me any reason to issue her one. J. Ryan said it appeared that I automatically assumed his son is guilty. I told him that is not the case, that his son has refused to provide his account of events. I explained his son could provide a statement, allow us to examine his computer and provide me with his cellular phone records so we can determine if what Alex said is true. J. Ryan said he informed his son not to provide a statement. J. Ryan said that I should know that lawyers advise their clients not to make statements to the police. I informed J. Ryan if his son is innocent it would make more sense for him to speak with me and provide his accounts. J. Ryan asked if I checked [REDACTED] background. I explained I had a criminal history check conducted and it revealed no criminal history. J. Ryan said he knows there was an incident at the Wellington Mall one to two years ago. J. Ryan said I needed to call security at the mall and ask them about the incident. J. Ryan gave me a number of [REDACTED] for security and the name of Chuck Barr. I asked J. Ryan if the Wellington Mall was in Palm Beach County. He said it was. I informed him I checked the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office's on-line booking information and she was not listed as being arrested in that county. J. Ryan said [REDACTED] use to work at Victoria's Secret and left in November. J. Ryan said her leaving was related to substantial losses or something in that line. J. Ryan said I need to ask her about when she worked for her boyfriend's business. J. Ryan asked if I asked [REDACTED] about the 45 year old and massages. I told him no, that it did not matter and I was not concerned with any of it. J. Ryan stated it has to do with veracity and if I check I will see she is not truthful. I explained to J. Ryan that his son's girlfriend said his son lied to her. J. Ryan told me to ask [REDACTED] about Victoria Secret, the 45 year old male and working for her boyfriends business. J. Ryan told me again to cal the mall security. I told J. Ryan I was not concerned with any of that and it had no relevance in this case. I explained that even if she had a criminal history it would have no bearing on this case and I was not going

to conduct a background investigation on her. I informed J. Ryan that he or his son were welcome to send me any information they wished to go with this report.

On 1/23/06 I forwarded an email to suspect John "Chris" Ryan's fsu garnet account. I informed Ryan that I had spoken with his father again and was advised that he (Ryan) will not be providing a statement in this case. I informed Ryan I wanted to make sure he was aware that he may submit evidence on his behalf. I advised it was my understanding that he will not provide consent for me to view his computer to prove the video does not exist. I informed Ryan if there is anything he would like to include with this report to let me know. I received confirmation that the email was delivered.

This would indicate that Velasquez called [REDACTED] before Ryan returned from class and that [REDACTED] was in the room with Velasquez before Ryan returned. [REDACTED] stated she called her mothers number when she left the room. Her phone records show she called her mother's number at 12:08 p.m. The phone records and card swipes indicate that Velasquez, committed Perjury by making a false statement under oath (837.12, F.S.).

On 1/25/06 at approximately 2:00 p.m. I made contact with Velasquez via telephone. I asked Velasquez if she could meet with me again to clarify some things. I explained there was some contradictory information she may be able to explain. Velasquez stated she already told me everything and she is not involved. Velasquez stated she did not see why she had to come in again. I advised Velasquez that I could not make her come in and that she did not have to come in. I informed Velasquez that I had evidence proving that she provided me with false information under oath. I explained the charge of Perjury and explained that recantation is a defense to the charge. I explained if she did not come in and make a clarification I would request a warrant for her arrest for Perjury through the State Attorney's Office. Velasquez stated she could not come in today or tomorrow but could come in on Friday. Velasquez stated she would meet with me on Friday at 2:00 p.m.

Later on 1/25/06 I received a voice message from Velasquez. Velasquez requested to know exactly what it was she lied to me about so she would not come up here and waste her time.

On 1/27/06 at approximately 10:44 a.m. I made contact with Velasquez via her cell phone. I informed Velasquez that I could not tell her exactly what I had to prove she lied. I told Velasquez I did have evidence showing that Ryan was not in the room when she called [REDACTED] and that he was not in the room when [REDACTED] initially arrived. I advised Velasquez that I wanted to give her the opportunity to clarify anything. Velasquez stated she could not come in today because she was sick. I advised Velasquez that I would wait until Tuesday, 1/31/06. I advised Velasquez that if I did not hear from her by then I will assume she is not going to meet with me to make clarifications.

As of 2/1/06 at 9:00 a.m. I had not been contacted Velasquez. I prepared an arrest warrant on Velasquez for Perjury, Not in an Official Proceeding, 837.012, F.S., Misdemeanor 1st. The arrest warrant was reviewed and approved by Neil Wade, Assistant State Attorney, State Attorney's Office on 2/1/06.

As of 2/2/06 Ryan has not contacted me or provided any documentation for me to submit with this report.

The allegation of Voyeurism by suspect John "Chris" Ryan is being referred to the Office of Student Rights and Responsibilities.

On 2/3/06 a judge approved and signed the warrant charging Velasquez with Perjury.

I forwarded information on the warrant to FSU PD Patrol.

As of 2/6/06 at 1:45 p.m. Velasquez had still not been booked on the warrant. At approximately 1:50 p.m. I made contact with Velasquez via her cellular phone. I informed Velasquez she had a warrant for her arrest for Perjury. I informed Velasquez she needed to turn herself into the jail as soon as possible or she would be picked up. Velasquez stated she had things to do so we would just have to pick her up.
