Q. Did you ever apply for or receive work authorization from United States Citizenship and Immigration Services or Customs and Border Protection which would have authorized you to accept employment in the United States as a non-immigrant?

Q. Did you pay any income tax on the money you received for working at the restaurant?

A. No.

Q. Did you receive any kind of public benefit while staying in the United States?

A. I had a social security card when I was here in 2009 as a J1.

Q. How much United States currency do you have with you right now?

A. \$16.00 United States dollars (Seen, verified and returned by CBPO Yousuf; witnessed by CBPO Juan G. Hernandez)

Q. Do you have any medical conditions that United States Customs and Border Protection should be made aware of?


A. I have a cold.
