All,

I spoke with [REDACTED] today and we discussed the various questions [REDACTED] had listed in his email below. She lives outside of Barcelona but said that Barcelona would be the closest city for her to travel to in order to see a therapist. She does not speak Spanish.

She would like to review the list of doctors that the Embassy could provide and understands that this list is not Embassy endorsed and we could not recommend a specific therapist for her.

She discussed her desire to provide a victim statement and had concerns that law enforcement was not interested anymore in hearing her story. We did talk about the possibility that her attorneys were working on arranging an interview although she didn't seem to be aware of that.

After speaking with [REDACTED] today regarding my conversation with [REDACTED] would like to review the list of doctors with [REDACTED] in order to assist her with identifying those who have experience working with trauma victims. [REDACTED] will also be able to discuss the number of sessions for which the Bureau will cover expenses (6) and how to submit documentation for payment.

[REDACTED] will you be able to obtain from ACS the list of doctors located in Barcelona and then forward same to myself and [REDACTED]

Let me know if I've missed anything and thank you all for your assistance and patience.

Hi all,

After speaking to ACS, it appears all they would really be able to provide is a list of English speaking doctors... not necessarily the best or anything of that nature. Inasmuch as she lives here.. and unknown to me, but presumably she speaks Spanish, this may not be the best option.

I recommend the following:

Can you reach out direct and speak to the victim to talk through a few things:

1. Where exactly does she live? This will matter because the list of doctors is mostly Madrid and Barcelona centric.
2. Does she need an English speaking doctor, or is she comfortable enough speaking Spanish.
3. Would she like the list or does she have her own doctor and is only looking to see what exactly we offer.
4. If I understand correctly, our services are a. getting her a list and b. advising how many sessions we pay for etc.
5. It needs to be said that the list is only a list of english speaking doctors, while it implies "embassy approved", many of these doctors the embassy knows very little about.. so they aren't endorsing these, the embassy is simply advising they speak english, just want her to understand that part of it.

So, can you reach out direct please. Her email is below but I don't see a number, but looking at the string she obviously spoke with in NY. Perhaps she has a #.
