Hi [Redacted] – there is no hard policy regarding the provision of services post indictment. The USAO is responsible for the provision of services post indictment. As you know, often times VSs are requested to support the victims due to their preexisting relationships and trust developed during the investigative stage. The victims in the Maxwell case should be provided transportation by the USAO or the case agent. Are you being asked to just provide transportation or also provide support during the trial?
