Thank you for assisting us and DOJ with the redactions.

Since this is going to be released to the public, I believe it is important all meta data, including names and times of the file, be striped to not create any issues where issues don't exist.

I will defer to OTD on the best way to do that.

Perhaps we create two options for DOJ.

One which is similar to the files [REDACTED] gave access, with the redactions. And the other having all substantive audio in one file, starting with the 4 way on the 24th and going continuously with the substance until concluded on the 25th w redactions.
