

Upon the application of the United States pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 2705(b):

1. The Court hereby determines that there is reason to believe that notification of the existence of the attached subpoena issued in the above-referenced investigation bearing U.S. Attorney's Office ("USAO") number 2022R00493 (the "Subpoena") will result in the following consequences, namely, flight from prosecution; destruction of or tampering with evidence; and/or otherwise seriously jeopardizing an investigation or unduly delaying a trial.

Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED:

2. The electronic communications service and/or remote computing service provider (the "Provider") to whom the attached Subpoena is directed shall not, for a period of one year from the date of this Order (and any extensions thereof), disclose the existence of this Order or the attached Subpoena to the listed subscriber of the account(s) referenced in the Subpoena, or to any other person, except that the Provider may disclose the attached Subpoena to an attorney for the Provider for the purpose of receiving legal advice.

3. This Order and the Application upon which it was granted are to be filed under seal until otherwise ordered by the Court, except that the Government may without further order serve a copy of this Order on any applicable Provider, provide copies of the Application and Order as need be to personnel assisting the Government in the investigation and prosecution of this matter, and disclose these materials as necessary to comply with discovery and disclosure obligations in any prosecutions related to this matter.
