I am working on the government's response to the subpoena served on the FBI by plaintiffs, seeking any sworn statements taken from [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] In my conversations with [REDACTED], she told me the FBI did not take sworn statements from any of these six women.

I am going to send a letter to the plaintiffs' attorneys, Mermelstein & Horowitz, informing them there are no documents responsive to their subpoena. Before doing so, I wanted to confirm with you that there were no sworn statements taken from any of the six women. I am hoping that my letter will satisfy plaintiffs regarding the non-existence of the records they request. However, we may have to provide a declaration attesting to that fact. When I spoke with FBI Paralegal [REDACTED], I asked who would be the appropriate individual to sign a declaration regarding the absence of any records. After she spoke with [REDACTED], she told me [REDACTED] believed the appropriate person would be the agent handling the case.
