It was good to see you yesterday. Thank you for accommodating my visit with Tartaglione and giving him extra time to review his discovery. We very much appreciate that.

I am writing to request the preservation of all video surveillance that captures the hallway outside of Tartaglione's cell on the date and time of the Epstein incident that is currently being investigated. I believe that the date and time is July 23 during the early morning hours. Accordingly, I would ask that all video surveillance from July 22 at 11 pm to July 23 at 4 am is preserved. If it is your understanding that the incident occurred at a different time, please let me know and preserve the relevant footage, including an hour before the incident and an hour afterwards. If the responding officers were wearing body cameras that captured the inside of the cell in the aftermath of the incident, I am requesting that such footage also be preserved.

We will be officially requesting this material through the appropriate means, but please consider this

email a formal preservation request.

Thank you. I will examine this more closely from a computer (hard to read on phone), but clearly the rate of suicides is increasing (as it is in the community), but it has gone up dramatically since 2010. A couple questions that perhaps we can discuss when we meet as described below:

Is it possible 2010 is so low because of poor data and reporting back then?

How does this increase compare to the rate in the community? How does it compare to state corrections?

As I've said, one of my priorities moving forward is suicide prevention, both staff and inmate (this started with my focus on staff suicides earlier this year, long before epstein). Let's discuss a plan and project to work on this. It's something I've discussed with [REDACTED] at different times this past year. I want to pull resources from across the bureau (other psychologists and ORE for example-at your discretion) to help on this and I have the Executive Staff's support and I'm sure I'll have the Director's support. Let's find a time to meet.

1. The attached spreadsheet has three tabs with counts on Attempts, Self Harm and Placement on Suicide Watch for all of our institutions between 2014-2018 and it was shared with IPPA.
2. This is a reporter's question sent to IPPA along with our response and my recommendation for adding more information.

(4) Also, does BOP have any special initiatives under way to help reduce the numbers? What is BOP's response to the union's contention is staffing shortages is at the root of the problem?

The safety of staff, inmates, and the public is the highest priority for the BOP.

The BOP works diligently to provide education to staff and inmates on suicide prevention. Every staff member receives annual training on this important topic, and many receive additional semi-annual training. After an inmate arrives at an institution, every inmate receives information on mental health services available to them. Psychology Services staff at each facility provides crisis intervention and support services as needed. Psychologists are available for formal counseling and treatment on an individual or group basis. In addition, staff in an inmate's housing unit are available for informal counseling. More information can be found on our website here [https://www.bop.gov/inmates/custody\\_and\\_care/mental\\_health.jsp](https://www.bop.gov/inmates/custody_and_care/mental_health.jsp).

I would just add that suicide prevention is mandatory and an integral part of our Introduction to Correctional Techniques I & II (Institution & Glynco); Annual Training; Semi-Annual Training; New Lieutenants Training, and Prior to working an assigned post in SHU. The first four items apply to all Bureau staff.

3. The second attachment is a collection of data Psychology Services does every year. 2018 and 2017 will likely have one more death added to each year. This were discovered this week, one at CAA and one at an RRC that PSB was never notified about.

Dr. [REDACTED] - I just spoke with an inmate who came out of the SHU last night. His room was directly next to Epstein's and Brown was anxious to describe the night of his neighbor's death. Jeffrey Epstein definitely killed himself. Any conspiracy theories to the contrary are ridiculous. Brown actually heard Jeffrey tearing up his sheet before committing suicide. I asked Brown if the SHU had been extraordinarily noisy and uncivilized as a prelude to Jeffrey killing himself. He responded in the negative - effectively refuting my theory that Epstein couldn't take the animals in the SHU and chose to end it as a result. I no longer believe that rooming with Jeffrey would have saved him. He wanted to kill himself and seized the opportunity when it was available (when his bunk moved out). Such is life - or death in this case.

Friday is my home confinement date and clearly, the staff hasn't done its job although the law specifically states that the BOP is required to let all inmates with the appropriate risks and needs (which I am) serve 10% of their sentences at home. I know this isn't part of your domain. But anything you could do to get me out of here when the law says I should be released (two days from now) would be most appreciated.
