Dear Mr. Johnson,

I heartily commend the officers and crew of M/Y THE MANU for the assistance rendered in the rescue and salvage of the M/Y GAME 7. In the early morning hours of January 17th 2015, the M/Y GAME 7 made an emergency distress broadcast and requested immediate assistance. The M/Y GAME 7 reported that they were taking on water with three persons on board and were preparing to abandon ship 22 nautical miles southeast of Virgin Gorda, British Virgin Islands. You immediately responded to an Urgent Marine Broadcast issued by Rescue Sub-Center San Juan and without hesitation diverted from your transit to assist the M/Y GAME 7. Once on scene, you promptly deployed a rescue and assistance team onboard the M/Y GAME 7 and displaying outstanding seamanship, made temporary repairs that ultimately saved the vessel from sinking. Your medical officer also provided care for a crewmember onboard the M/Y GAME 7 who was displaying signs of shock. After your crew expertly conducted emergency repairs, you unselfishly diverted from your intended voyage and towed the M/Y GAME 7 to a safe mooring in Spanish Town, Virgin Gorda.

The actions of the officers and crew of the M/Y THE MANU are in keeping with time honored traditions of mariners assisting those in peril at sea. Thank you for your generosity and professionalism.
