Sultan,

I am not sure what discussions you are having, but you may find it helpful to know that in the last month DPW shares in London have attracted some leading international investors – many of whom were new to the stock and couldn't invest in Dubai.

Conversely, Dubai has only attracted one shareholder, albeit they have bought 3 million shares so London is attracting more shareholders than Dubai. 25% of the shares are now held in London.

As one final point, our top 5 shareholders now own 40% of the free float – this is the reason why the liquidity (ie volumes) are so low because those top 5 shareholders are not selling shares.


