Thank You for contacting Medaire Yachting for medical assistance. Please allow me to summarize the medical concern as reported.

You have been having sharp right mid abdominal pain since last night. Temp of 37.8. Normal bowel movement last night. No medical history and no allergies to medications.

I have reviewed your case with the doctor and we would like to know if you still have your appendix? If you have not had your appendix out in the past, we would recommend that you go shoreside for an evaluation to rule out appendicitis.

Please revert back as soon as possible to let us know if you have your appendix. We will be happy to provide you with a referral for a shoreside evaluation.

In the meantime, you can take some tylenol and ibuprofen for the pain.
