Dear dear Jeffrey,

It was absolutely wonderful! He repeated pretty much exactly what he said on the plane and resisted all of my attempts to persuade him the language might say something else. Woody Allen knows his own mind! . So we had some excellent conversation about the poem as a fairly hostile dashed off note by a serial adulterer (which is correct, since Williams was) and some amusingly abortive little-half conversations in some other directions. But that turned out to be great too. Students will find it funny and wonderful that I keep trying to get him to see the poem in another way and he says: nope. I will probably have a whole class that is based on listening to, and responding to, that discussion.

I am so grateful to you, Jeffrey, for what was a fantastic experience (my camera crew was swooning too) and what will be a fantastic part of the course.

The course launched today (just the poems of New England) and there are already students around the world talking online about it. We have something approaching 10,000 signed up for early New England. Have you registered?
