> This is a brief list of information to help get u up to speed.

>There are three basic fitting types
>
>JIC (joint industry council) 37 degree
>AN (Army/Navy) 37 degree
>SAE (society of automotive engineers) 45 degree
>
> JIC and AN are alike and use a 37 degree sealing/mating surface..
>These are High Pressure Fittings
>
> SAE fittings are low pressure fittings and use a 45 degree
>sealing/mating surface.
>
> Hose can be a bit complex but are basically one wire reinforced
>or two wire reinforced and come in various pressure and use ratings.
>
> I consider all hose generic if they match the pressure and use
>rating for the application and SAE (society of automotive engineers
>standardized configuration) specification.
> (yes, the society of automotive engineers specifications help control
>the configuration for JIC and AN fittings too)
>
> I hope this is brief and understandable... It is generalized
>information and avoids to many specifics
>
