Here is his summary of himself:

"I am a biologist and author working to promote synthetic biology and open source biology. To my mind, DNA is a programming language that scientists have been working to reverse engineer with increasing success. Synthetic biology allows forward engineering, permitting scientists to write code de novo and allowing logical, fully understandable evolution of biological outputs ranging from single proteins to synthetic bacteria. I advocate the use of open source principles for creating DNA code. In software development, these have led to robust code, highly skilled developer communities, and non-monopolistic pricing -- ie good things for end users. Open biology could potentially create a more diversified and sustainable biotechnology industry."
