Greetings Jeffrey,

I came across some info this morning, and thought you may be interested.

This morning I was called into the Oakland Air Route Traffic Control Center (aka ZOA ARTCC) to help debug some ATC automation software (which I'd helped to develop) operational anomalies. While there the FAA System Command Center (FAASCC, near DC) issued an advisory about the Fukushima Radioactive Cloud. There have been aviation advisories about this cloud since the earthquake. This morning, however, the location (presented as a perimeter defined by lat/long vertices) changed. Up 'til this morning the cloud was above Fukushima. This morning's advisory indicates this cloud extends farther south, toward (but not yet reaching) Tokyo.
