The first major survey to put the story of Europe into its global context=2C Evans's new work covers every country in Europe, not just th= 'Great Powers', and brings out their common features a=d the links between them in a transnational approach. In conversation wit= Margaret MacMillan, Evans will link technological advances to social e=ancipation and innovative politics, explore the transformation of relig=ous faith, highlight the impact of the explosion in literacy and commun=cations, and explain how the competing models of French revolutionary p=litics and English political gradualism were bypassed by powerful and dan=erous nationalist sentiment across the continent.

This talk is a must for both those who want to know more about an age that=is receding rapidly into a remote past, and for those who want to under=stand the origins of our own age and its problems, from extreme nation=sm and religious fanaticism to environmental pollution and the gap betwee= rich and poor.
