Below is the info on Jacqui Safra's properties for sale. One is the Sherover Residence, the alpha property in Jerusalem close by the official residences of the President and Prime Minister. He's been offering it to Russian oligarch for \$100,000,000 but know it will go for less. Second is prime property in Calistoga, CA, near his vineyard. He bought it at the behest of the guy who owned Aman resorts. The idea was to develop into a very high-end resort with private villas. Third is a huge property in the gold mining area of Nevada. About (900 sq miles) - 20 miles long x 23 miles wide. 550,000 acres leased from the US government; Jacqui owns 130,000 acres outright.

Around the time Jobs came back to Apple, Jacqui almost made the investment that was picked up by Gates. He says he had \$3 billion in cash in those days. A lot of it he's spent on properties and mostly on his art collections which is in a vault in a mountain (go figure!). His big investment is Spring Mountain (900 contiguous acres). The Vineyard loses money every year but the land is about \$300,000 an acre. He's not selling because, he points out, the same kind of quality vineyard land in France sells for \$25 million an acre. So he's intent on developing Spring Mountain.

#### THE SHEROVER RESIDENCE, JERUSALEM

At the heart of heart of Talbīyah, Between Dubnov and Pinsker Streets, the most prestigious neighborhood in Jerusalem. Built in 1958, the villa has been described as "the largest and most splendid built in Jerusalem after the establishment of the state"

"The Sherover Residence and Bronfman House"

"The large plot of land between Pinsker and Dubnov Streets, on the southern edge of Talbīyah was empty until the late 1950s. Over the years, along these streets — in the most expensive part of the city — houses have been built by wealthy families.

"In 1958 at the western edge of this area, the first house was completed: the Sherover residence at 2 Pinsker Street, built by Miles Sherover, an industrialist and businessman from Venezuela, with his wife Rita. The villa, the largest and most splendid built in Jerusalem after the establishment of the state, was located on an area 1.5 acres that also included a large garden and a swimming pool. The house was planned by three well-known architects from Venezuela and designed in the style of luxurious Latin American homes. One of the design elements characteristic of this style is seen on the facade: a colorful mosaic that adorns the sloped parapet around the roof.

"For years the house and the garden that surrounds it served as a meeting place for Israel's high society. After Miles Sherover's death in 1976, his wife thought to put the building at the disposal of the government as an official residence for state visitors and other important personages. Her offer was not accepted because of the high maintenance costs and security problems involved in such a residence, which can be solved more easily at hotels. Eventually the lot on which the house was built was split and Gita Sherover built a smaller villa for herself. The big house, including the swimming pool, was sold to a banker from the Safra family.

Two adjoining lots that form a rectangle of approximately 60,000 sq ft (with approximate dimensions of 300 ft x 200 ft)

Present building rights are 50 per cent, so the property could go up to a total of close to 30,000 sq ft.

PLAN: Build the top luxurious hotel in Jerusalem, with some luxury apartments. The building rights would then go to 150 to 200 per cent, but the procedure would take 3 to 4 years. The city government wants to encourage more hotels, so my understanding is that they will subsidize about 30 per cent of construction costs, and will help to expedite the permitting process. [Note: For Security reasons, Google Maps will not be clear.]

88 acres on a hill acquired in 1998.

PLAN: Jacqui acquired the property on the advice of Adrian Zecha, former owner of the exclusive Aman resorts, (No. 1 Hotel Chain, World's Top Hotels. Resorts & Spas. Zagat Survey) who recommended acquisition of the property with an eye to development of the most exclusive resort in the Aman Resort portfolio (<http://www.amanresorts.com/home.aspx>). In addition to the hotel, the plan would have called for 20 very high-end villas for sale at \$15,000,000 each.

DLF, India's largest real estate company, acquired Aman Resorts in November 2007 for \$400 million. As of 2010, Goldman Sachs was advising DLF.

The property is about 10 miles from Jacqui's Spring Mountain Vineyard in Mt. Helena and close to Napa airport.

Jacqui has \$15,000,000 to \$20,000,000 invested. He's looking for \$50,000,000 to \$60,000,000. If want to see it, he invites you to stay at the mansion at the Vineyard for a couple of nights.
