1) Create and support "Science Madrasah" (designed like the ones described here: <http://www.zeenews.com/news64499.html> <<http://www.zeenews.com/news644999.html>> that the Thai government has been working on)

a. Transforms formula to attract kids into organized learning institutions... but moves them toward progressive competencies that will create a base of expertise in which more serious science can flourish.

b. Positive alternative when families decide on best long-term objectives for their children

c. Needed to strengthen core competencies resulting in a society with skilled scientists
