Any of it could be done with excavators.

It will just take two, full time. One with a hammer on it and a second with a bucket. The trench will be a minimum of two feet wide with 8" and far more invasive by far than a trencher. Also, in order to get to the proper depth, 36", the excavators will have to do a minimum of two passes each for every foot of trench due to the maximum plunge depth of the hammer which is roughly 20-24".
