I finally got to Rosario. I am working on several violations in San Juan for the COE and he had to come out and do a site visit on one of them so I trapped him! He has not been ignoring us he has 99 cases to deal with, and he just has not look into LSJ as yet.

We went back to his office and he pulled out the file, and was amazed when he saw how old many of the issues are. In the file there were also 8.5 x 11 photographs taken by Judy Pierce and on them was a note from Sindulfo telling Vivian she need to address this as soon as possible since was getting a lot of public attention. After reviewing the file Rosario felt the best course of action would be for him to visit the site before he did anything.

I am to send him an e-mail stating the sites he needs to look at with current violations which he should be able to close in the VI so he can justify his trip. I will draft the e-mail later tonight and will sent if by for your okay before I send to Rosario.

This means that we need to makes sure we have all the issues I have pointed out addressed prior to his visit.

Its good news he has taken no action on the case. The bad news is that he has now been delegated to be the EPA's enforcement officer as well, which means he will also be looking at and have jurisdiction over all the erosion control and water quality issues.

What was Jeffrey's take on the suggested work items. We really need to implement these things and these are not things that should just be left for Brinsley or others on the island to take care of. This is part of the reason things have gotten so out of hand.

I think we have a chance to bring this all to a close, but it is going to mean we really make sure the site is perfect, and to the greatest degree possible in compliance. And once we get the island in compliance lets keep it there!
