Good morning JP,

I have attached the permit for the two mooring buoys that was issued to LSJ, LLC in June of 2011. You will note that the permit allows for a "double screw anchor" for the moorings. We believe that it is customary to have three (3) screws in a triangular pattern to provide the most strength in different wind conditions. Would LSJ, LLC need to apply for another permit or an amended permit in order to install a third screw?
