The middle #2 engine requires its 8 year corrosion inspection, Larry Morrison recommends having our engine inspected as oppose to locating a exchange engine with possible additional cost bill back.

Price for the 8 year corrosion inspection with guarantee no Bill back is \$237,000.00 from Miami Engine shop, I spoke to the overhaul shop, if our turbines are not as corroded as expected we could expect approx \$20,000 less final invoice. turn time is 35 - 40 days,. see attached estimate.
