

Good news. I was able to find a fast internet connection here on St John, and so I won't need to go over to the other island to be able to view images. As a bonus I had my colleague Michael


Trese (whom I am staying with) and is widely regarded as the world's authority on FEVR look at the images with me. Serendipity often beats careful planning!
