Here are the projects for tomorrow:

Landscaping:

MAIN PRIORITY! Main Compound landscaping continued by Chris and Jason. Still

needs plants replaced by concrete slab to tunnel as well as the gap in the hedge in front of master bath. New plants on tables.

Palm tree fronds damaged by wind cut down (all island)

General clean-up and weed removal

Electric:
