Some researchers conclude that little difference exists between men and women in terms of sexual behavior.^{[221][222]} Other researchers disagree.^[223] Symmetrical men and women have a tendency to begin to have sexual intercourse at an earlier age, to have more sexual partners, to engage in a wider variety of sexual activities, and to have more one-night stands. They are also prone to infidelity and are more likely to have open relationships.^[43] Additionally, they have the most reproductive success. Therefore, their physical characteristics are most likely to be inherited by future generations.^{[224][225][226][227]}
