All told, contributions to DAF accounts captured about 4 percent of approximately \$316 billion given to charity in 2012. Assets under management totaled \$45.35 billion last year, up from \$38.14 billion in 2011, a gain of 18.9 percent. Contributions to DAF accounts grew 34.6 percent in 2012 to \$13.71 billion, compared with 2011's total contributions of \$10.19 billion.

DAFs grew by almost every metric . The total number of DAF accounts jumped from 188,487 in 2011 to 201,631 – an increase of 7 percent. In 2007, there were 160,415 accounts with \$31.97 billion in assets under management. The average size of a DAF account grew 11.2 percent last year, from \$202,341 in 2011 to \$224,921 in 2012.

Grants from DAF accounts also grew last year to their highest level in five years: \$8.62 billion, up from \$8.08 billion in 2011, a 6.7-percent increase.
