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I have attached a photo of the wall we will be using to cover in the mirror. I have updated, more exact measurements of this wall which are:

32' 1.5" wide

20' 9" tall

Notches are 38" wide by 16 " high

Please note, the measurements for the 2 "notches" at the top which I will also need to add to our order 2 pieces of mirror for these. Can you please suggest the best sizing for the panels using these updated measurements?

Also, the client is asking me to order 100 additional square feet of mirror "just in case".
