FYI: This is a classic example of how easy it is to conflate issues -- eg. today 10 april a policeman guarding polio workers was shot dead -- the media are reporting it as an attack on the polio workers -- but rdetailed esearch into similar events reveals that the targets are the police, not the polio health workers *per se*. There is an important political tussle between 3 political parties in the 3 towns where health & social workers have been targetted.

"...One policeman was killed another wounded Wednesday 10 April while protecting a polio vaccination team in Mardan district of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. The incident took place in Par-Hoti area of Mardan where two armed motorcyclists opened fire over a polio vaccination team. The police men were escorting a three member polio team --consisting two women and a man-- when they were attacked.

"One of the policeman embraced martyrdom and the second sustained injuries **while the polio team remained unhurt**", said District Police Officer (DPO) Tahir Ayoub...."
