- Maybe her native Hard woods as,well would be good to add on some of the barren slopes, as sort of a reforestation that will increase the attraction of rainclouds, become a home/sanctuary for local birds and help reverse the loss of valuable topsoil when it rains.

- Also she has some very nice coastal, salt tolerant vines/ that can cover boulders/ barren areas
