>>> Kathy's DC home has a 4 year old flush mounted TV and in-ceiling

>>> speakers

>>> that she's happy with. I think she'd love AppleTV, since most her

>>> viewing

>>> is with Netflix, but fully replacing the tv and speakers would be

>>> disruptive.

>>> She's gut renovating the basement right now to turn it into a guest room
>>> and has wired speakers into the ceiling there as well, with a flush
>>> mounted tv and receiver cabinet as well. She's also run wires for
>>> speakers
>>> in the backyard but isn't sure what speakers to get or how to set them
>>> up.
>>>
>>> Her office is on the second floor on the other side of the home from
>>> wifi
>>> access point, so the internet connection there can be spotty.
>>>
>>> I suggested she have the contractors that are running the wires for the
>>> speakers run network cables to the office and to the basement from the
>>> existing router, and then we could add AirPort Extremes to each of those
>>> locations. Jeffrey offered to buy those as well, but we need the wires
>>> run
>>> before we can set those up.
