Basically, the Preva activation allows Precor to directly interact with the unit, as well as allowing the user to save their exercise onto a mobile device (it can do this with the Preva App or a specific set of other exercise applications). Finally, it involves installing the internet and cable connections for the machine if there are inputs at the installation area. Mr. Epstein can elect to go without the Preva and save \$150.

Nat strongly encourages you to take advantage of them setting up the Preva as it is a complicated system.
