Larry, you guys have to show proof of insurance coverage for Belarus visa and a copy of your insurance card alone is insufficient. Read the Belarus requirements. You must call your insurance company( which I assume is united healthcare and request a foreign coverage letter be faxed to you. It takes 3biz days for a fax. Takes 10-15 biz days to have mailed. They must fax to you only. No 3rd party fax numbers. I will forward you Jeffrey's letter they sent. I also included copy of card and a copy of his policy. I would request this right away if you have not already
