

A Lecture by Henry Urbach, Director of The Glass House







**The Hands On-series continues with a class on bicycle maintenance.**






Laura Gauld will lead this workshop where parents, educators, and professionals interested in learning new ways to address the myriad challenges adults face in raising children and teenagers.






Prepare yourself for the world of 3D printing. We will be conducting weekly classes on using the Library's latest technology, a MakerBot Replicator 2x 3D printer.
