On August 21, 2019 at approximately 1305 hours, the undersigned, along with Special Agent [REDACTED] of the Office of the Inspector General, Special Agent [REDACTED] of the Federal Bureau of Investigation and Assistant United States Attorneys for the Southern District of New York [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] did interview Federal Bureau of Prisons correction guard [REDACTED], date of birth [REDACTED], at the Southern District of NY.

[REDACTED] informed that he has been with the Federal Bureau of Prisons (BOP) since 2000 and assigned to the Metropolitan Correctional Center (MCC) since 2001. [REDACTED] is currently the "rec" or recreation officer at MCC and has steady Saturday/Sunday days off and was not working when Epstein initially arrived at MCC or when Epstein was found hanging in his cell in the SHU on August 10, 2019.

[REDACTED] informed that his last interaction with Epstein was on the August 9, 2019 while doing an escort with officer [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] told Epstein that he would need a new cellmate since [REDACTED] was released.

Further details of the interview and statements made by [REDACTED] are recorded on the interview notes attached to this report.
