



██████ denies participating in any of these incidents. She believes that the victims may be mistaking her for another person.

At Epstein's direction, ██████ took nude or partially nude photographs of one minor victim. This did not take place in the context of a massage and Epstein was not present when the photos were taken. ██████ did not know that the victim was a minor at the time the photos were taken and when Epstein told ██████ that the victim did not want them anymore, ██████ discarded the photos.

In or about 2005, ██████ learned that law enforcement was investigating Epstein for sex crimes involving minors, arising from the massage appointments, some of which ██████ had scheduled. After learning about the investigation into Epstein, at Epstein's direction, ██████ called multiple minor victims and encouraged them to "help" Epstein and conveyed that Epstein would help them if they helped him. ██████ encouraged them to talk to Epstein's investigator and offered that Epstein would pay for an attorney for them. In one or two cases, ██████ offered financial incentives to victims. ██████ understood that by asking her to make these calls, Epstein intended to dissuade the victims from speaking to law enforcement, and by agreeing to make the calls and take these steps, she was aiding him in this objective. Beginning in approximately 2006, multiple minor victims were interviewed by federal law enforcement officers who were conducting a criminal investigation of Epstein and his associates for sex trafficking of minors, among other federal offenses. During those interviews, minor victims reported to federal agents that Epstein paid them for sexualized massages while they were underage girls, including during massages that ██████ scheduled.
