Private as he was, Mr. Epstein was apparently concerned about what the public thought of him. A mutual friend arranged for him to meet [REDACTED] a public relations consultant. [REDACTED] said on Monday that their first meeting, at Mr. Epstein's townhouse, took place three years ago.

Mr. Epstein was not ready to re-emerge in the public eye — not then, anyway. Three months ago, Mr. Epstein called and invited him over to discuss damage control, [REDACTED] said.

"He hates every story starting with 'billionaire pervert,'" [REDACTED] said. "Jeffrey had long stories about the difference between pedophilia with very young children and tweens and teens a little older." He added, "It was his way of trying to talk his way around it."

[REDACTED] said he ultimately declined to work for Mr. Epstein. He said he had misgivings about Mr. Epstein's sincerity.
