**Re: *United States v. Ghislaine Maxwell, 20 Cr. 330 (AJN)***

Dear Counsel:

The Government writes to provide you with information regarding [REDACTED]. In particular, below is a verbatim English translation of an excerpt of information that the French Ministry of Justice provided to the Government. Ms. [REDACTED] is represented by [REDACTED]. Please note that this letter is governed by the July 31, 2020 Protective Order in this case. **In particular, the letter is designated as “confidential” under the Protective Order.**

- [REDACTED] “met Jeffrey Epstein and his partner Ghislaine Maxwell at the age of 16, in the south of France near [REDACTED]. They had made friends and she went to their Parisian apartment on Avenue Foch in 2000. The same year, she left for Miami with the couple[;] 6 months later, she was invited to New York by Ghislaine Maxwell, near the 5th avenue. It was during these 5 days that Epstein touched [REDACTED], who tried in vain to resist him. She remembered in particular that he had [REDACTED]. She had never met Jean-Luc Brunel.”
