The Times is hearing that there's some recent activity in the DOJ-OIG inquiry into management of the MCC that was initiated after Epstein's death. ██████ had said a few weeks ago, in response to a CBS inquiry that I let them know about, that there's no 'new' investigation, but ██████ and colleagues are hearing there has been recent activity in the ongoing inquiry. I asked ██████ about this Times inquiry (see below), but I haven't heard back. I'm happy to provide whatever guidance you think appropriate. ██████ asking because he wants to keep his pledge not to discuss business when you meet.

For your awareness, there is still an ongoing DOJ-OIG investigation that, broadly speaking, is about Epstein's death, but the focus is on institutional failures and it isn't new -- this has been in existence and moving slowly since the day he died. Besides that, there's nothing to this that I'm aware of.
