had spoken earlier today. Here is the original letter sent on Oct. 11, 2020.

To

Whom It May Concern:

Over

the last several months, I have been following the case concerning Ghislaine Maxwell with great interest. I am happy that your office took the necessary measures in arresting her. I, through extraneous and circumstantial evidence believe her to be guilty.

Though I have no doubt in my mind that SDNY prosecutors along with the FBI are trying their very best in compiling a substantial and compelling case against her, I think that you know that she is not the true prize in the contest. There are many others involved

and that, through various means, should create a cascade of confessions and plea deals. I think this to be the greatest of all victories, the dismantling of the corrupt system.

We had talked some time ago when your office first began to investigate the anomalous plea deal with Epstein. Still let me reintroduce myself. My name is [REDACTED] I had worked very briefly with reporters at MSNBC and the New York Times in the Harvey Weinstein investigation. During the normal course, it did become apparent that Epstein required due diligence as well.

I do not have necessarily new information concerning Epstein or Maxwell that you should already be aware of. Nonetheless, time is ticking and I understand the need for completeness on your part. I am willing to help the Department of Justice as required in connecting the dots.

In continuum, I wanted to re-highlight the points made about Natalie Portman and Reese Witherspoon both attempting to assist Maxwell in finding me. I am unaware of the exact reasoning as to why but believe that this was due to the obviously misguided opinion that I would somehow be able to kill the investigation. Bob Iger, then CEO of the Walt Disney Company also tried to do the same but with greater zeal. He had hired a private investigator which seems absurd to me until I began to really question his motives and make best guesses about why he did so. I believe that Maxwell had indeed ingratiated herself substantially with the previously mentioned and Hollywood at large.

To support these claims, I would recommend subpoenaing my phone records from Verizon Wireless. My phone number at the time was 858-761-3770. In these phone logs, you will find numerous calls from various individuals involved. It should also be noted that I think they perhaps regularly called from Disney conference rooms based in Burbank, California as well. Giving your investigators a heads up. You have my permission to retrieve this information (if this is somehow necessary).

I am fully willing and capable of either conducting a phone interview or coming up to New York, whichever seems more conducive for you.

There is a balance remaining with me and the Department of Justice as well that I would like to close. Please review your records concerning.

There

is one final matter. I would like the investigation reopened by the FBI into the Walt Disney Company into the theft of funds from their dividend reinvestment program. I do not believe that the agents assigned were thorough in their case review.
