- 1) What is the first PDF (title "CDB_Office Phone Numbers")? It is the only PDF in the folder for [REDACTED].
- 2) Second PDF is a letter to Ferrer (former US Attorney in SDFL). [REDACTED] had made him a separate folder in 3500. We obviously don't want a folder for Ferrer. I don't think we need to include this in 3500 for other witnesses but please let me know if you disagree.
- 3) Third PDF is an internal FBI email about a witness named [REDACTED]. Page 2 has some description of the guy, but second para refers to FBI working on different investigation. It seems this was included as part of the package and I'm inclined to just redact the para about the other investigation, but let me know if you disagree.
- 4) Fourth PDF – [REDACTED], this seems to relate to the issue you flagged earlier about state GJ testimony. I found in [REDACTED] folder but it is going to be in several victim folders. Should we just tell [REDACTED] to produce pages 14-24?
- 5) What did we decide on draft transcripts of microcassette tapes? (E.g., [REDACTED])
- 6) On victim files that are multiple pages and contain the mapquest pages, I don't think we should bother to ask [REDACTED] to remove those pages from the PDFs, but if you disagree please let me know.
- 7) [REDACTED] are law enforcement folks – their 3500 materials consist of either just the 87 page PBPD report or other reports. I'll make sure [REDACTED] checks that the PDFs are in other folders but don't think they need separate folders. Let me know if you disagree.
- 8) [REDACTED] – I moved the internal paperwork for us paying for her to travel to NY. That said, it seems this will be an issue for several people. Do we need to ask [REDACTED] for NTW travel benefits?
