2:10 p.m. Call from [REDACTED] said that in 1996, a priest from St. Edmund's Church in Warren, Michigan, Father [REDACTED] asked [REDACTED] to meet with Jeffrey Epstein to translate. [REDACTED] said that this priest knew Jeffrey Epstein. Epstein had 30 girls from the Middle East and none of them spoke English. [REDACTED] said he was 15 y/o at the time. This occurred in California and Florida. [REDACTED] said that when he arrived, there were 30 girls in the basement. He said they told him they were promised jobs. [REDACTED] said they were sex slaves. [REDACTED] said he was forced to have sex with men. [REDACTED] said that he was on heroine at the time. One day he took a wallet off the dresser and jumped out the window and escaped. Epstein sent a bodyguard to [REDACTED]'s house in Michigan and threatened to kill him if he told anyone about the girls.
