Doing rounds ensure officers are doing jobs. inmates have the opportunities to address concerns. Tries to walk floors based on time.

On weekdays takes 4pm count. He or other Ct (operators). Take a verbal count by speaking w/ every unit and make w/ cart slips from interval and if correct clear institutional count.

Cannot clear the count until a good verbal from every unit.

Not aware of any instance of count clearing count w/o speaking to every unit.

Tries to watch cameras as taking call counts to ensure others are actually counting, but cannot monitor all activity due to activity in count.

Usually released before 10pm Has heard of a situation of a home when the count was not properly completed. (2)

As a Lt. ~~the~~ works to enforce policy through verbal counseling and by example. Court is one of the most important duties as professionals.

She is responsible for doing 30 minute rounds. As a Lt. he signs off on forms if they are correct.

Has never signed off on forms that were filled out in advance and would report if he had.

Has never witnessed one that appeared to be patterned, would address it he had.

Trains officers to detect road patterns.

Has heard stories about officers not completing 30 min rounds in the shoe, recently w/ Epstein death, but nothing recent heard in past btw 5-10 years.

2003 & several years following other suicides occurred @ MCC.

Was on duty the night Epstein came to MCC. Relieved @ rear gate and observed him being ③

processed in. Deems of to go
to General population. Was not
aware of his high profile. He

Knew Epstein to be in
legal visits constantly often
until 7-8 pm. Other than
in take questions on first day
did not have interaction w/ Epstein.

Was not involved in regards
to Epstein's first alleged suicide
attempt.

Brought him food on several occasions
there, but no interaction.

Was aware he has moved back
to the show.

Was aware he needed to have a
cell mate. (Mass email)

Had no conversations w/ anyone
that have roommates.

Did not have any conversations
with anyone that Epstein was required
to have a roommate.

Lt. Rice was show Lt. MC
believes he would have known
as it is a regular responsibility. (4)

Believes Lt. Rice would have entered the roommate note.

Worked Aug 9 2-10 (release @ 9:50-55) was not aware JE did not have a roommate. Did not know Rejes had left MCC and thus JE had no cellmate. Did not find out until the following morning.

Was working operation. R. Silvia was working as acting actives Lt. she made rounds that evening (he was working night, being OT)

If had known JE did not have a roommate would have known he did b/c knew he was on hotlist.

Following morning approx 6:30-245 got a call that JE had attempted suicide and not go to jail, straight to hospital. (Lt. Stanley Jean called)

At hospital, escorting staff stated he JE had passed. Saw his body, told officers not to speak to anyone, direct any questions to PR officer, same to hospital Sgt
