When I arrived at the airport today, I received a text from Kate Briquet (a journalist at The Daily Beast). She asked me very suggestive questions regarding the victims meeting. I told her I was not allowed to speak about

anything related to the FBI. She pressed further and asked about the co-conspirators and if the FBI is continuing the investigation. I told her to ask Dawn Schneider, David Boies's PR, who was at the victims meeting. Dawn Schneider had introduced me to Kate in July. I did not tell Kate I was coming to New York. While at the victims meeting Dawn asked me to encourage other victims to attend a Glamour Magazine story she was orchestrating. We did not arrive together, I shared a car with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. She was keen and observant as to who was in the room. As I spoke to another victim (represented by Ms. Allred), she visibly eavesdropped on us and asked me to ask her to come to the Glamour Magazine event. After the meeting, while people were talking she reminded me again to ask her. I introduced myself to her lawyer and told her (the victim) about the Glamour Magazine interview. She declined. She also asked [REDACTED] and her attorney if they would be interested in attending. Since we were asked to ask on her behalf I believe [REDACTED] was asked multiple times. I asked her too. If you have any questions please let me know. I do know who I spoke to, and have their contact information. Please keep my information and this email private. I do not wish to offend anyone, only point out how problematic and unethical this is.
