Details:

On 07/08/2019, at 11:44 a.m. Eastern Time, [REDACTED], date of birth [REDACTED], cellular telephone number [REDACTED], home address [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] called the FBI National Threat Operations Center (NTOC) to provide information on Jeffrey Epstein.

[REDACTED] provided the following information:

[REDACTED] worked for [REDACTED], NY in 1999. Epstein was a client of theirs. Epstein would come in to buy things for his "nieces" but he would never answer any questions [REDACTED] had in regards to his nieces. [REDACTED] thought that was odd.

Epstein never brought any girls into the store with him but [REDACTED] remembers seeing Epstein walk by the store with young girls who appeared to be in their late teens. [REDACTED] does not believe the girls were Epstein's neices.

The store in [REDACTED] closed in 2002 or 2003. [REDACTED] advised there is a store at St. Armand's Circle in Sarasota, FL, exact business address unknown. [REDACTED] said that store may have Epstein's purchase records.
