Details:

On 07/08/2019, at 11:50 a.m. Eastern Time, [REDACTED], date of birth [REDACTED], cellular telephone number [REDACTED] address [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] called the National Threat Operations Center (NTOC) Unit regarding being a previous employee of Jeffrey Epstein.

[REDACTED] provided the following information:

In 2003, [REDACTED] was placed into Epstein's New York Strategy Group by the temporary staffing agency [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was 23 years old at the time and was covering for a woman on maternity leave. [REDACTED] claimed she had not been assaulted or felt uncomfortable while there but felt Epstein was trying to groom her. Epstein offered to fly [REDACTED] to his island but she did not go. Epstein offered to take [REDACTED] to see her father in New Mexico but they first went to his Palm Beach, FL home where she was supposed to fly from to New Mexico. A few days passed before [REDACTED] was taken to the airport where her flight got canceled so she flew back to New York. While at Epstein's home, [REDACTED] saw two other females who claimed to be 19 and 20 years old. During this time, [REDACTED] did not hear any similar accusations or anything illegal to her knowledge. [REDACTED] claimed Epstein was also involved in a modeling agency.
