- seal already broken for 1B32

- based on identifiers on photocopy, device appears to be old drive, can't tell if computer or image made of computer

- sticker w/ [REDACTED] initials

- [REDACTED] also wrote 1B32 sticker

- 31E-NY-3027571 - case number

- every item gets unique identifier from LART, that is NYC #

- parent # is same as NYC # indicates did not come out of something else (e.g., another device)

1B29 - photocopy on box has device w/ different identifiers than photocopy on 1B32

- bag lists agency as DaveKleiman.com, date of collection July 26, 2007

[REDACTED] initialed, wrote 1B29 sticker

- suggests from JE's original arrest

photocopy on boxes indicate same drive - 1B36, 1B32, 1B33;  
serial numbers are the same

photocopy on boxes indicate same drive - 1B35, 1B31, 1B29

photocopy on boxes indicate same drive - 1B34, 1B37, 1B30
