After being advised of the identity of the interviewing Agents and the nature of the interview, [REDACTED] provided the following information:

This situation came on [REDACTED] radar around 2008-2009 which he started paying attention to it. [REDACTED] ([REDACTED]) told [REDACTED] some things and [REDACTED] researched some things. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] about a meeting with "you guys", referring to the investigative case team.

Around [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] moved to [REDACTED] and that was good for [REDACTED] and [REDACTED].

When [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were living together, [REDACTED] asked her how they paid bills growing up because he had known that [REDACTED] [REDACTED] tells [REDACTED] that someone helped to pay for her school. When [REDACTED] was drunk it would come out and she would break down. She would tell him that it wasn't for free. She received a lot of money from JEFFREY EPSTEIN (EPSTEIN) and [REDACTED] [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] tells [REDACTED] a story that on one occasion there were other girls there and one girl in particular started to cry because she didn't want to go into "the room". At this point in the story [REDACTED] gets vague with [REDACTED] but stated the girl didn't have to go in and [REDACTED] would go in. [REDACTED] did not give [REDACTED] details of what actually happened in the room but she would say it wasn't free and she had to "do things" and "it wasn't fun". EPSTEIN is like [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED] asks [REDACTED] if she had sex and she responds by crying.

EPSTEIN manipulates [REDACTED] like [REDACTED] did to her. [REDACTED] [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] did not want to tell [REDACTED] all the gross details so she would stop telling him details after she says "massage".

Other girls would be there. Often [REDACTED] was being told what to do. She had to do it, [REDACTED] would tell her to go.

[REDACTED] tells [REDACTED] that when she was about 10 years old [REDACTED] made [REDACTED] sit on a prominent old man's lap. At some point, [REDACTED] calls [REDACTED] out and [REDACTED] observes this conversation. She says to [REDACTED] "how could you not know?...I put a roof over our head". [REDACTED] [REDACTED] denies knowing.

[REDACTED] recalls [REDACTED] saying that there was a woman that was with EPSTEIN. She tells this to [REDACTED] around 2008-2009 but does not tell him the woman's name at first. [REDACTED] says that this woman would bring girls and she was always there to coach them and be there for the girls. She would encourage the girls and tell them that it's OK. Eventually [REDACTED] tells [REDACTED] that this woman was (GHISLAINE) MAXWELL.

[REDACTED] recalls at the time saving some links on his computer in a folder containing EPSTEIN articles. [REDACTED] did not want people to know [REDACTED].

Someone had contacted [REDACTED] to ask her questions about EPSTEIN. It was then that [REDACTED] pieced it together that the guy that she was going to see was EPSTEIN.

[REDACTED] recently told [REDACTED] that she does not want [REDACTED].

When it all became public is when [REDACTED] recalls that she started telling him in bits and pieces but [REDACTED] would do his own research on his own. When [REDACTED] would drink she would break down and tell [REDACTED] and then regret it the next day. [REDACTED] didn't have to ask her what happened after it became public. [REDACTED] learned that it was EPSTEIN when it all became public and he pieced it together. By when it all became public, [REDACTED] is referring to the first time that EPSTEIN had gotten in trouble. Prior to this, [REDACTED] just knew that [REDACTED] was approached by just a "rich old man".

[REDACTED] didn't learn of MAXWELL's real name until EPSTEIN actually went to jail more recently and he pieced it together again. Someone had found a [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] recalls asking [REDACTED] 'Is that the woman?' once MAXWELL's name became public around this time. [REDACTED] asked [REDACTED] this within the last 3 years. [REDACTED] had been the one to remind [REDACTED] about "the girl" and [REDACTED] was surprised that [REDACTED] remembered [REDACTED] telling him about her.

[REDACTED] tells [REDACTED] that she met DONALD TRUMP when she was with EPSTEIN when she was about 15 years old. EPSTEIN says to TRUMP "Oh she's a good one right" to which TRUMP responded "Yeah". This happened at Mar-A-Lago. [REDACTED] says that TRUMP was a regular visitor at EPSTEIN's.

[REDACTED] also says "Prince Albert" was there a lot as well.

Everything that [REDACTED] read on the news lined up with everything that [REDACTED] had previously told me about the situation.

[REDACTED] knows that [REDACTED] was meeting with the government on the date of this interview and he knows [REDACTED] is also meeting with the government. [REDACTED] tells [REDACTED] to be prepared as it may be tense.
