 After being advised of the identity of the above listed individuals and the  
 nature of the interview, ██████████ provided the following information:

██████████. She originally met EPSTEIN and MAXWELL when she was at summer  
 camp in Interlochen Michigan. ██████████ believed this was around ██████████ of  
 ██████████ when she was 13 turning 14 years old. When ██████████ was 14 years old,  
 she flew for the first time on EPSTEIN's private jet to New York from  
 Florida. ██████████ gradually started to move to ██████████  
 ██████████ When she visited at this time she would stay in  
 EPSTEIN's apartment building. ██████████ spent her junior year at ██████████  
 ██████████. When ██████████ was 17  
 going on 18 years old, ██████████. ██████████ was 18  
 when she started her senior year of high school in ██████████; EPSTEIN  
 paid for her education.

██████████ traveled to Santa Fe, New Mexico with EPSTEIN and MAXWELL  
 approximately three times. When EPSTEIN was in New York, ██████████ would  
 visit him at his New York home. MAXWELL wouldn't be around them much at  
 this time; ██████████ did not believe that EPSTEIN and MAXWELL lived together  
 when in New York.

EPSTEIN's office would call ██████████ and say something to the effect of  
 "Mr Epstein would like to see you tomorrow after school...or this weekend".  
 ██████████ was not sure if MAXWELL ever called her to make appointments.  
 MAXWELL was very present in the beginning. When in Florida, MAXWELL and  
 EPSTEIN were always together. MAXWELL being around always made it seem

safer to [REDACTED]. MAXWELL traveled with them on the plane almost always in the beginning. When in Florida, EPSTEIN or his office would call [REDACTED] house. Often, [REDACTED] mother would answer the phone. In the early days, [REDACTED] did not really want to go to EPSTEIN's house when they called, [REDACTED]  
[REDACTED].

Early on, when travel arrangements were made, they were done by MAXWELL if it was a commercial flight. MAXWELL would talk to [REDACTED] about the arrangements. MAXWELL may have been facilitating the arrangements for travel and forwarding the information to a secretary to book. On one occasion, MAXWELL brought [REDACTED] to JFK. When they would buy [REDACTED] the plane tickets, [REDACTED] felt as though she had to go. They would just tell [REDACTED] that the tickets were bought without asking her first. The tickets may have been dropped off at her house by a messenger or one of EPSTEIN's drivers. His driver would pick [REDACTED] up and bring her to the airport. [REDACTED] only reason for traveling to New York in the beginning was in connection with visiting EPSTEIN.

MAXWELL was present for sexual contact in New York but not as present as she was in Florida. [REDACTED] recalled at least one incident in New York where MAXWELL was present. They were in a room, which [REDACTED] described as "dungeon like". EPSTEIN first had sexual contact with [REDACTED] when [REDACTED] was 14 years old. MAXWELL helped to facilitate the situation and its casualness. MAXWELL would normalize the situation and act as if she was [REDACTED] cool older sister. MAXWELL would say everything is ok and make it seem like this is what grown ups do.

[Agent note: Not all details were discussed during this interview.

[REDACTED] agreed to possibly speak at another time.]
