

Notes from phone call with [REDACTED]

- Team followed up with [REDACTED] re: *The Lion King* Broadway show having premiered in 1997
- [REDACTED] said she realized her recollection of that having been a first trip (or early trip) was mistaken, that the trip stuck out in her mind because of the show but that it would have been a later visit
 - o Recalled the show specifically because Epstein bragged and claimed that he knew Julie Taymor. [REDACTED] believed it was to try to impress her.
 - o [REDACTED] recalled that the seats for the show were very good, and that Epstein bragged they were difficult or almost impossible to get
- [REDACTED] did not recall details about transportation for that trip, how she got to or from New York – may have been commercial flights or the jet or a combination
- [REDACTED] still very confident that she started traveling to NYC with (and/or to visit) Epstein when she was 14, in the initial months after meeting Epstein and Maxwell.
- Recalled that approximately 90% (nine out of ten trips) or more she was abused by Epstein or Epstein and Maxwell during times she was in New York
 - o As an example of confidence in this belief, [REDACTED] noted that she specifically recalls a trip to New Mexico during which she was *not* sexually abused as being notable and very unusual
- Remains very confident in her recollection of abuse, including that Maxwell was present and involved in abuse from early on
