Present for the interview was AUSA [REDACTED] AUSA [REDACTED], AUSA [REDACTED], Detective [REDACTED], and Special Agent [REDACTED]. After being advised of the identities of the above listed individuals and the nature of the interview, [REDACTED] provided the following information:

[REDACTED] attended INTERLOCHEN in approximately [REDACTED], [REDACTED]. In [REDACTED], [REDACTED] attended [REDACTED] but [REDACTED] was not sure if [REDACTED] also attended. [REDACTED] and in the summer of [REDACTED] at INTERLOCHEN was when [REDACTED] first started talking about a man (JEFFREY EPSTEIN) for whom she had a sense of admiration. [REDACTED] EPSTEIN approached [REDACTED] at the picnic tables. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] the day of or shortly after she met EPSTEIN. [REDACTED] would have been 14 years

old when she met EPSTEIN. [REDACTED] did not recall if [REDACTED] referred to him as "JEFFREY" or "JEFFREY EPSTEIN". It became clear that EPSTEIN lived in Palm Beach, which was a "cool coincidence". [REDACTED] did not recall the first time he met EPSTEIN. The first memory [REDACTED] had of meeting EPSTEIN was in [REDACTED] at a movie theater. [REDACTED] met EPSTEIN, and [REDACTED] and GHISLAINE MAXWELL were also present. [REDACTED] assumed that MAXWELL was EPSTEIN's girlfriend/partner. [REDACTED] did not remember if that was the first time he met EPSTEIN, but did recall that it was the first time that he met MAXWELL. When [REDACTED] met MAXWELL, he was approximately [REDACTED] years old, while [REDACTED] was 15 years old. [REDACTED] did not recall meeting EPSTEIN while at INTERLOCHEN, so assumed he met EPSTEIN for the first time in Palm Beach. [REDACTED] assumed EPSTEIN just started hanging out with [REDACTED] or she was going to his house.

The second or third year at INTERLOCHEN, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] stayed at EPSTEIN's cabin at INTERLOCHEN. EPSTEIN was not there when they stayed. EPSTEIN communicated to [REDACTED] that they could stay there.

[REDACTED] told [REDACTED] that MAXWELL had told her, "Oh I would teach your brother a thing or two".

EPSTEIN was a "godfather figure" and wanted to help [REDACTED]. EPSTEIN wanted to do a lot of nice things [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] heard this from [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] reported that it never felt weird, but now looking back it does. [REDACTED] recalled that [REDACTED] was going to EPSTEIN's home days/weeks/months after first meeting EPSTEIN. [REDACTED] felt that it was pretty soon after camp. [REDACTED] felt that [REDACTED] had gone over in the day time. [REDACTED] did not think [REDACTED] had stayed the night at EPSTEIN's home, but she could have. EPSTEIN sent a driver, who [REDACTED] described as a very nice Latin man. [REDACTED] only remembered EPSTEIN's driver because he was very friendly. They talked about Latin music together. [REDACTED] could not recall his name.

When [REDACTED] and his family had moved to another house in approximately [REDACTED] he recalled answering the phone and EPSTEIN was on the other line. [REDACTED] always told them to be polite. EPSTEIN was always curt and to the point saying something like, "Can I speak to [REDACTED] please?". [REDACTED] spoke to EPSTEIN on the phone a handful of times and it was always the same. [REDACTED] did not remember if he talked with MAXWELL on the phone.

When [REDACTED] met EPSTEIN in person, EPSTEIN seemed weird; EPSTEIN was in sweatpants and seemed like a homeless person. [REDACTED] had told [REDACTED] at some point that she remembered EPSTEIN having dinner at their home; [REDACTED] did not remember this but thought it would have made sense because [REDACTED] had people over all the time.

[REDACTED] went to [REDACTED] in approximately [REDACTED] for her [REDACTED] year of high school. Before she left for her [REDACTED] year, [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] about EPSTEIN's house. [REDACTED] would have been [REDACTED] when she told him this. [REDACTED] did not know who made travel arrangements for [REDACTED]; he did not know if they were commercial or private. [REDACTED] recalled that [REDACTED] has spoken to [REDACTED] over the years about it. [REDACTED] recalled [REDACTED] said she went with [REDACTED] to buy a dress [REDACTED] EPSTEIN's New York City house had seven stories; [REDACTED] talked about the house. [REDACTED] felt that MAXWELL always traveled with [REDACTED] and EPSTEIN. [REDACTED] mentioned MAXWELL a lot. [REDACTED] would go to events and places with EPSTEIN and MAXWELL; [REDACTED] talked with [REDACTED] about it. [REDACTED] remembered that [REDACTED] had told him that she met DONALD TRUMP at MAR-A-LAGO in approximately [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] about this meeting at the time it happened. [REDACTED] felt that he met EPSTEIN and MAXWELL a couple times. [REDACTED] remembered approximately 10 years ago seeing EPSTEIN's face in the media. [REDACTED] recognized him so he believed that he had met EPSTEIN more than once.

In approximately [REDACTED], [REDACTED] told him to write music for EPSTEIN's birthday. [REDACTED] spent six hours writing music, titled "Fanfare for Jeffrey".

EPSTEIN purchased [REDACTED] and his family a computer that was delivered to their home by his driver. [REDACTED] thought this happened shortly after INTERLOCHEN. [REDACTED] thought it was used before EPSTEIN gave it to them. This is the only thing [REDACTED] remembered receiving from EPSTEIN. [REDACTED] seemed to think that there was no doubt that [REDACTED] received gifts from EPSTEIN; [REDACTED] thought this made sense that EPSTEIN would do this. [REDACTED] had no specific memory of [REDACTED] receiving a gift. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] that she had been to EPSTEIN's New Mexico ranch.

[REDACTED] has had conversations with [REDACTED] over the years where [REDACTED] told him that EPSTEIN gave [REDACTED] large amounts of cash.

When [REDACTED] was [REDACTED] in New York City, he stayed in an apartment in Manhattan owned by EPSTEIN for a couple of days. [REDACTED] did not know how he was able to stay at EPSTEIN's apartment. There was a friendly door man, who [REDACTED] thought may have given him a key; [REDACTED] thought the doorman may have told him that he was friends with EPSTEIN. While in the apartment, a girl walked in and introduced herself as [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] did not know [REDACTED] was staying there. [REDACTED] was 19 years old when he met [REDACTED] who was 23 years old. When [REDACTED] walked in, she told him that she worked for EPSTEIN.

[REDACTED] had not seen [REDACTED] in over a decade when she reached out. [REDACTED] saw her in [REDACTED] in November 2019. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] that they needed to talk about EPSTEIN. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] that she was surprised it took him so long to ask about EPSTEIN. [REDACTED] asked [REDACTED] if she knew, and [REDACTED] told him no. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] that this situation has ruined her life and that [REDACTED] had written a book with [REDACTED] in it. [REDACTED] believed [REDACTED] when she said that she did not know the extent of what EPSTEIN was doing. [REDACTED] was paid to work for EPSTEIN; she was basically a slave. [REDACTED] met BILL CLINTON with MAXWELL present. CLINTON asked [REDACTED], "What do you do?". MAXWELL told CLINTON that [REDACTED] was her slave. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] that she knew nothing about what has been reported about EPSTEIN. [REDACTED] had wanted to talk to [REDACTED] because he knew she had worked for EPSTEIN and figured that [REDACTED] had to have known something. Throughout [REDACTED] friendship over the years with [REDACTED], they never talked about EPSTEIN and MAXWELL. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] that she was MAXWELL's assistant and described herself as MAXWELL's slave.

[REDACTED] did not exchange emails with EPSTEIN, nor has he been to any of EPSTEIN's other properties. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] recently that she had been to EPSTEIN's Palm Beach house. [REDACTED] felt that [REDACTED] had been to EPSTEIN's Palm Beach house but was not sure.

When [REDACTED] saw the news reports, he thought that there was no way something had not happened to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] told him that she had taken [REDACTED] out for lunch and told [REDACTED] that she knew something had happened to her, telling her that she knew she was raped. At first, [REDACTED] denied it to [REDACTED], then she broke down.

Approximately 10 years ago when the investigation of EPSTEIN first came in the news, [REDACTED] subtly mentioned what happened to her. [REDACTED] never

overtly told [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] never asked. There was a lot that was implied. [REDACTED] thought that he had asked her if she was ok, and [REDACTED] replied, "How do you think I feel; I was raped by a pedophile for years". [REDACTED] has opened up more in recent years.

[REDACTED]

In the early 2000's, when [REDACTED], a massage therapist came to give him a massage. This masseuse worked for EPSTEIN. EPSTEIN was still very much in [REDACTED] life at this time.

[REDACTED] did not remember if he had talked with [REDACTED] in person or over the phone when the investigation all came out. [REDACTED] did text [REDACTED] when EPSTEIN died, telling her that EPSTEIN was now out of her life. [REDACTED] then realized that was not true, that things were just beginning.

When [REDACTED], [REDACTED] told him that EPSTEIN co-signed for their lease. [REDACTED] When they sublet the apartment, the person did not pay the rent and EPSTEIN contacted [REDACTED] and told her that she needed to take care of it.

[REDACTED] said that EPSTEIN paid for INTERLOCHEN. [REDACTED]

Early on, [REDACTED] had respect for EPSTEIN; she loved how smart he was. EPSTEIN said things like, "An ozone repairs itself before a man could ruin". [REDACTED] did not know what the turning point was for [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] would say that it was the lunch she had with [REDACTED] that was her turning point.

The news outlets were blackmailing [REDACTED] saying that she needed to give an interview or they would write whatever they wanted. [REDACTED] thought that she may have paid an attorney to make the media go away.

[REDACTED] recalled seeing a [REDACTED] saying that a woman named [REDACTED] was raped.

[REDACTED] expressed that she did not want this to ruin her life. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] that he would support her in whatever she decided. This conversation happened approximately six months prior to this interview.
